Designed to provide teachers with an opportunity to hone their skills to help teach and demonstrate the primary science curriculum there will be three workshops: 'Light, Shadows, Colour' (Energy and Forces); 'It's a CASE of Using Your Head' (Materials) and 'The Foibles of Plants' (Living Things, Environmental Awareness and Care).

Throughout each workshop, the focus will be on developing teachers' skills and confidence in the classroom and finding methods of encouraging students to develop an inquiring mind for science.
